THE HERSHEL "WOODY" WILLIAMS MEDAL OF HONOR FOUNDATION

Hershel "Woody" Williams is the last surviving Marine from WWII to wear the Medal of Honor. He was awarded the Medal of Honor for his actions while fighting in the Battle of Iwo Jima.

Woody co-founded the Hershel "Woody" Williams Medal of Honor Foundation, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization dedicated to honoring the fallen and their families, primarily through the placement of a Gold Star Families Memorial Monument in every state.
